Vice Provost Update

HLC Kick-Off meeting (breakfast) - Need direct evidence of assessment of student learning

- Gigi Fansler, HLC liaison said we need direct assessment of student learning outcomes within our programs. Needs to be a clear part of our process going forward.
- We are going to, additionally, ask all of our programs to choose one of their signature assignments to assess and have them report on that next fall.
- Our accredited programs already do direct assessment, but they will also be asked to provide that information to the HLC.
- Alana will present the curriculum mapping process to the Provost's Deans + Staff meeting on November 20th.

VALUE Institute Project

IUPUI Assessment Institute - Curriculum Mapping

- The Assessment/UTC office is working on a core syllabus review (400+ syllabi), with a December 6th deadline.
- Alana and Michele attended the IUPUI Assessment Institute this year Alana attended a full-day workshop on curriculum mapping.
 - o Hosted by Jennifer Harrison and Vicki Williams from UMBC.
 - Jennifer has been invited to come speak at Assessment Day, as the kickoff to helping all of our dept. chairs and those aiding in the curriculum mapping process.
 - o Template (handout) from UMBC they use a numbers system, which is what we will now use.
 - Service units can be included in this curriculum mapping discussion/workshop.
 - For service units, if you do not have learning outcomes there are maps that align strategic planning goals to programs and activities in services provided by service units.
