quantitative studies from Johns Hopkins University and a Master's in educational measurement and statistics from the University of Iowa.

Linda worked seven years as a vice president at the Middle States Commission on Higher Education. Her higher education experience includes work in assessment, institutional research, strategic planning, and quality management.

Linda's latest book is *Five Dimensions of Quality: A Common Sense Guide to Accreditation and Accountability*, with a foreword by Stan Ikenberry. Her previous book, *Assessing Student Learning: A Common Sense Guide*, is one of the top-selling books on assessment in higher education.
