

# Transfer Equivalency Guide



Rocket students who pursue a bachelor's degree meet several types of requirements; all must fulfill the UToledo CORE requirements in liberal arts. The University of Toledo honors the following Washtenaw Community College courses with credit for equivalent courses as listed. UToledo degrees will include CORE courses from seven categories, as follow in the chart.
