Math Placement for Entering Students

The Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) degree at UToledo requires students to take at least one Core math course of **MATH 1320 – College Algebra** – or higher. The first math course you are placed into is usually based on a combination of your ACT/SAT math score and your high school GPA. If you begin in MATH 1200 your first semester, you will need to earn a C- or higher in that course to move on to MATH 1320 in the Spring of your freshman year.

If you have already taken College Algebra or higher as a CCP student or have earned a 3 or higher on the AP Calculus Exam, you will not need to take any additional Core math courses for the BBA degree. Please be sure to submit your college transcripts and/or AP scores to UToledo before your Rocket Launch date so that your advisor will know to omit a math course from your Fall 2022 course schedule.

If you do not have an ACT/SAT score or if you want to place into a higher math class, then you can take the ALEKS math placement test.

WHAT IS THE ALEKS MATH PLACEMENT TEST?

ALEKS is an online system that uses adaptive questioning to quickly and accurately assess student knowledge. The ALEKS math placement test can be accessed on any computer with internet access that meets the system requirements.

Taking the ALEKS math placement test gives you the opportunity to place into the math class you are actually prepared for, saving you time and money that would have otherwise been spent on an unnecessary prerequisite class. You will have a total of 3 attempts to get your best possible score.

HOW DO I TAKE THE ALEKS MATH PLACEMENT TEST?

To take the ALEKS math placement test, visit <http://www.utoledo.edu/it/aleks>

You will need your UTAD username and password to access ALEKS. If you have not yet activated your UTAD account, visit <https://www.utoledo.edu/orientation/new/utad-account.html> for step-by-step directions.

There is a **non-refundable \$20 fee** (paid by credit card) to access the ALEKS math placement test. This fee is assessed by McGraw Hill Education once you log in with your UTAD credentials. The University of Toledo does not accept payment for ALEKS.

With the \$20 fee you will obtain access to:

- One initial placement test
- A 6-week subscription to the Prep and Learning modules to elevate your current math knowledge
- Two additional “re-take” placement tests which you may take to raise your placement score
