

J-1 Prearrival Checklist

The following information will help you prepare for your arrival at The University of Toledo. Contact your UT Department or OISSS with any questions or concerns.

SEVIS Fee	<p>Pay the \$220 SEVIS fee before your visa interview. Print out the receipt and present at the visa interview. You only need to pay one SEVIS fee, which will cover the J-1 DS-2019 and J-2 Dependents.</p> <p>Pay the fee at http://fmjfee.com.</p>
Important Documents	<p>Have all immigration documents in a safe place as you travel. Bring your DS-2019, passport, and visa. Keep these documents in your carry-on baggage. You will be assigned an I-94 number at the U.S. border (to retrieve it, go to https://i94.cbp.dhs.gov).</p>
Health Insurance	<p>The U.S. Department of State requires that all J-1 Exchange Visitors and their dependents present proof of health insurance. If you will be responsible for purchasing health insurance, the following website is a resource for providers:</p> <p>http://www.nafsa.org/resourcelibrary/default.aspx?id=8823</p>
