#### **Program Introduction**

The Intensive English program is a short-term customizable employee training program hosted by the Center for International Studies and Programs at the University of Toledo. It is developed for international companies and institutes who seek educational experience for their employees in the chosen field of expertise. Participants benefit from this program through improving their communicative English skills, enhancing their knowledge of American social and academic culture, and exchanging ideas with American experts in the chosen field.
