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

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

# Schwartz's Principles of Surgery

1. Select editors  
(from US geographic distribution)
2. Find an editor: Katie Elsbury
3. Editorial Board meeting(s)
4. Select Table of Contents (44 to 49 chapters)
5. Select senior authors (changed 75%)

# **Schwartz's Principles of Surgery**

- 1. Send out invitations and a sample chapter**
- 2. Set deadlines and monitor progress**
- 3. Write front matter**
- 4. Select artwork (each chapter and cover)**
- 5. Galley phase (proof actual chapters)**
- 6. Publication (>2000 pages, 54 chapters, 2 year process, repeats every 3 years)**
