Subject: Robbery attempt



SYNOPSIS:

The University of Toledo Police Department is investigating an incident occurring today, Wednesday, February 24 at Barnes and Noble bookstore at 8:16 a.m. A female employee of Barnes and Noble reported 2 unknown male suspects approached the cash register and passed a note to her demanding money and indicating a suspect had a gun. After a short verbal exchange the suspects ran out the door toward Dorr Street. No injuries were reported and a gun was not observed. Money was not given to the suspects.

Victim described the suspect as follows:

Suspect1: White male, approximate age late 30s to 40s, about 5'08", average build with brown scruffy facial hair wearing glasses, a dark gray hoodie and blue jeans.

Suspect2: White male, approximate age early 30s dirty blonde hair, thin build, taller at about 5'11" to 6'00" wearing a lighter gray hoodie and blue jeans
