Full Tanks

 Full tanks will continue to be delivered to the tank room





Partially Full

 According to Joint Commission, as soon as tanks or cylinders leave the tank room they are considered "Partially Full"



In Use

 Tanks are considered "in use" when on a stretcher, a bed, a wheelchair, or code





Empty



- When a cylinder is "empty" (below 500 psi), they must be placed in a carrier.
 - Carriers are located on each floor in the room by the elevator.
 - 3rd Floor "empty" carrier is located in 3145.

Filled Carrier

- When the carrier is filled with "Empty" cylinders, it MUST be taken to the tank room on Dowling Hall Dock, Room 0140
- Place "Empty" cylinders in appropriate location in tank room



Labeling

- The empty cylinder holder will be labeled "Empty Cylinders"
- Partially full cylinder holders will be labeled "Partially Full Cylinders"
- IMPORTANT: Do not comingle "Empty Cylinders" and "Partially Full Cylinders" on the floors
 - This helps eliminate confusion and delay in care
- Transportation carts should be labeled with a "partially Full" sticker. Do not leave empty cylinders in carts
