Good Afternoon Everyone,

Below are the August post-meeting agenda notes.

Committee Updates

- Committee members are highly encouraged to bring forth agenda items as they are needed. If committee members would like to include an item for discussion, please reach out to Tyler at least one week before the next meeting to ensure it gets added to the agenda and so Tyler can include pertinent notes for the committee.
- As a friendly reminder our meetings start at 3:00pm, please ensure you are there as soon as possible so we can use as much of our time effectively as possible. Also, all committee members are highly encouraged to bring their deputy and/or send them in their absence.

Agenda Items

- **Foam Dressings (Smith & Nephew & Mölnlycke):** The foam dressing category within advanced wound care was previously split between Smith & Nephew and Mölnlycke. The CVA Committee formed a subcommittee made up of in-house SMEs to evaluate major suppliers, including Medline, Mölnlycke, Smith & Nephew, Convatec, and Coloplast. The subcommittee conducted vendor interviews during Q1 2026 and selected Medline, Mölnlycke, and Smith & Nephew as finalists for product trials. Following completion of the trials in 3rd QTR, the subcommittee recommended aligning the foam dressing portfolio with Mölnlycke. The Nursing CVA Team **APPROVED** the recommendation to convert all foam dressing SKUs to Mölnlycke.

Action Items:

- Tyler to reach out to Dr. Nazzal and inform him of the CVA approval.
 - Tyler to add information to build form to get the foam dressings converted. Tyler to send pictures to staff education for infobytes messaging.
- **Securement Dressings (Sorbaview):** The committee reviewed the current Sorbaview securement dressing supplied through Medline, along with the Solventum-recommended equivalent product. The Nursing CVA Team **APPROVED** the conversion of the existing Sorbaview dressing to the Solventum equivalent.

Action Items:

- Tyler to add information to build form to get the single item converted and skued. Tyler to send pictures to staff education for infobytes messaging.
- **Surface Disinfecting Wipes (Clorox):** The committee reviewed the single Clorox surface wipe sku and the PDI recommended equivalent, and it was determined that the PDI item was **NOT APPROVED** for the following reasons:

- PDI wet time requires 4 minutes, while Clorox requires 3 minutes.
- PDI has a higher concentration bleach, concern of possible damage to equipment with higher concentration.
- PDI wipes in past have left a heavy residue on equipment
- The Clorox sku is built into many SOPs and protocols which would possibly require a review and possible rewrite.

Action Items:

- Tyler sent committee reasoning to vendor, Tyler will reach out to committee and/or IP with any other follow up action items.
- **Regional Anesthesia (Multiple):** The committee reviewed the current regional anesthesia portfolio alongside the B. Braun recommended equivalent portfolio. The Nursing CVA Team **APPROVED** the conversion of the existing items to the corresponding B. Braun products.

Action Items:

- Tyler to add information to build form to get the single item converted and skued. Tyler to send pictures to staff education for infobytes messaging.
- **Oxvir Trial Update:** Justin is currently reviewing Diversey's approved equipment spreadsheet. An update can be given at the September meeting.
