Agenda Items

- Wound Care (Cardinal):** The Wound Care supply category was converted to Cardinal items, but two items were missed during the initial conversion. An Applicator 6in Cotton tip and a 2in x 2in sponge gauze standard. The Nursing CVA Team **APPROVED** the conversion of both items.

Action Items:

- Tyler to add information to build form to get the two items converted and skued. Tyler to send pictures to staff education for infobytes messaging.

- **Bowel Management Systems (Convatec):** The committee reviewed the Convatec offerings against the current. While the committee did not feel that there was a problem converting, they requested a trial period to ensure that the Convatec kits work and solicit staff feedback.

Action Items:

- Tyler to work with Convatec and Nursing to determine trial period and est. # of kits needed.

- **Wound Drainage (Medline):** The committee reviewed the wound drainage offerings, and it was determined that these items are O.R. and physician specific. Therefore O.R. will review with physicians and determine if a conversion is advisable.

Action Items:

- Tyler to work with Michelle Mundy and O.R. group to review Medline offerings for possible conversions.

- **Advanced Wound Care Update:** Advance Wound Care Committee is currently conducting trials for the foam dressings. Tyler will update committee on trial results in the June meeting.

- **Oxivir Trial Update:** Justin is currently reviewing Diversey's approved equipment spreadsheet. An update can be given at the June meeting.
