- **OXIVIR TRIAL UPDATE:** CVA Committee **APPROVED** the below trial parameters:
 - Trial Duration:** One Month
 - Trial Start:** Approx. February 2026
 - Trial Locations:** SICU; MICU; Senior Behavioral Health
 - Cost:** Vendor will provide one month's product free of charge and provide free onsite education and support.

- Infection Prevention is compiling equipment list for vendor to review and gain product approval use on.

- Infection Prevention has provided evaluation criteria for the trial, please review below and let Tyler know if you would like to add any criteria or have questions about any of the criteria:
 1. Compared to our current purple top wipe, how easy was it to remove a single wipe from the container?
 2. How did the moisture level and ability to cover surfaces compare to the current product?
 3. Compared to the current product, did this wipe leave more, less, or similar residue/streaking?
 4. How much impact does the reduced contact time have on your workflow?
 5. Did the surface stay visibly wet for the required contact time?
 6. If you had to choose today, which product would you prefer to use?

- **ADVANCED WOUND CARE UPDATE (Multiple SKUs):** Advanced Wound Care Subcommittee was formed in December 2025. The subcommittee in coordination with Dr. Nazzal's team are reviewing the Advanced Wound Care category. The Subcommittee elected to break down the category into subsections and evaluate them in pieces. This is to ensure the team can spend a thorough amount of time evaluating each subcategory in order. Currently the team is evaluating foam dressings and vendor presentations are scheduled for end of January. Once vendor presentations are complete, the team will provide a recommendation as to if a trial is necessary and which vendors are recommended for trialing.

Action Items:

- Vendor presentations for foam dressings are scheduled for January 22nd (Vendors included are Medline, Smith & Nephew, Molnlycke, Convatec)
- Post presentation evaluations will be completed by subcommittee, subcommittee will determine next steps
- Tyler will provide updates of subcommittee progress at the February CVA monthly meeting.
