Below are the September post-meeting agenda notes.

Committee Updates

- Committee members are highly encouraged to bring forth agenda items as they are needed. If committee members would like to include an item for discussion, please reach out to Tyler at least a week before the next meeting to ensure it gets added to the Agenda and so Tyler can include pertinent notes for the committee.
- As a reminder our meetings start at 3:00pm, please ensure you are there as soon as possible so we can use as much of our time effectively as possible. Also, all committee members are highly encouraged to bring their deputy and/or send them in their absence.
- The September meeting was the last meeting as a "Commit Program Taskforce" Starting in October this committee is now the "Nursing and Patient Care CVA. This is the first of three value analysis committees to be relaunched. As time allows, I will provide more details at the October meeting.

Items Reviewed

- **Durable Medical Equipment (L#86811;1922;1923):** Committee **APPROVED** the conversion to the Medline brand durable medical equipment.

Action Items:

- Ken Fry provided approval to go straight to conversion, NPC review not needed.
- Once Supply Chain has completed the conversion, Tyler will reach out to Jill and she will send out an infobyte on the product change to the clinical staff. (Tyler to send pictures of current and new items for visual purposes for clinical staff.
- **Bowel Management (L#71613;71614):** Committee determined a **TRIAL IS REQUIRED**.

Action Items:

- Tyler to provide Ken Fry samples of the Convatec kits for NPC review.

- Once NPC provides feedback, if a trial is warranted, Tyler will work with applicable departments to obtain product and conduct trial.
- Post trial, if approved, Tyler will reach out to contract manager and work with supply chain to initiate the conversion process.
- Once supply chain has completed the conversion, Tyler will reach out to Jill and she will send out an infobyte on the product change to the clinical staff. (Tyler to send pictures of current and new items for visual purposes for clinical staff).
- **Tray Thoracentesis Kit (L#11138):** Committee **DID NOT APPROVE** the conversion to the Carefusion Thoracentesis tray.

Clinical reasons for non-approval:

- Ease of opening was better with current tray
- Glass ampules provided in Carefusion tray considered more dangerous
- Chloro prep was better positioned in the current kit making clinical ease of use better with current tray

Clinical Initiative

- **Surface Clean Wipes:** Infection prevention has requested a trial for Oxivir surface wipes. If successful, the Oxivir wipes would replace our PDI disinfectant wipes across the institution with the exception of our bleach wipes. The committee briefly discussed and recommended a full review at the October meeting.

Action Items:

- Tyler to provide committee email copies of the SDS sheets for the PDI and Oxivir wipes.
- Tyler and Infection prevention will have a meeting with Bio-med to understand if there is any medical equipment we cannot use Oxivir on.
- Tyler to provide up-to-date cost analysis at the October meeting
