## **COURSE/CATALOG DESCRIPTION**

Academic advisor approved industrial or non-profit internship to provide an experiential learning component to the PSM track in the Master's degree program.

## STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES

Students will participate in an internship at an industry, governmental organization, or non-governmental organization in an area relevant to green chemistry and engineering. The internship will culminate in submission of a written report documenting the duration of the internship, hours worked, nature of the work, and products of the work. Specific outcomes and associated products will be determined by the sponsor in conjunction with the instructor and can include:

- Conduct, summarize and/or present a comprehensive literature review in the topical area
- Develop new manufacturing processes or modify existing processes for enhanced sustainability
- Formulate new products or reformulate existing products for enhanced sustainability
- Evaluate product and/or process sustainability metrics
- Develop sustainability protocols and methodology
- Gather and/or develop relevant data needed to evaluate sustainability
- Analyze data and discuss results in written reports
- Present projects and results in a format acceptable for publication/presentation
