



CITIZEN/ELIGIBLE NON-CITIZEN DOCUMENTATION REQUEST

The Office of Student Financial Aid has received the results of your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Your response to the citizenship question on your FAFSA has been compared to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's database and has resulted in a discrepancy. The U.S. Department of Education requires us to resolve discrepancies; therefore, please follow the instructions on this document carefully.

YOU MUST BE A U.S. CITIZEN OR ELIGIBLE NON-CITIZEN TO RECEIVE FEDERAL AND STATE FINANCIAL AID.

When you arrive on campus, you are required to bring original documentation of your citizenship status to Rocket Solution Central for authentication. Acceptable documentation is listed below. Your financial aid will not disburse to your student account until your original documentation has been received and reviewed.

▶ If you are a U.S. citizen, present one of the following original documents to Rocket Solution Central in person:

- U.S. Birth Certificate if born in U.S., not foreign-born
- Certificate of Naturalization
- Consular Report of Birth Abroad (Form FS-240)
- Certification of Report of Birth (DS-1350)
- U.S. Passport
- Certificate of Citizenship
- Certification of birth issued by a foreign service post (Form FS-545)

▶ If you are an eligible non-citizen, present one of the following original documents to Rocket Solution Central in person:

- Permanent Resident Card (I-551). If expired, you must also present Form I-797 Notice of Action that notes the extension period.
- Resident Alien Card (I-551)
- Arrival/Departure Record (I-94 or I-94A) stamped with "Processed for I-551" with expiration date
- Arrival/Departure Record (I-94) stamped with "Temporary Form I-551" with appropriate information filled in
- Arrival/Departure Record (I-94) with designation of Refugee, Asylum Granted, Parolee, or Cuban-Haitian Entrant
- Foreign-issued passport with DHS/CBP admission stamp with SQ1, SQ2, or SQ3 class of admission or CQ1, CQ2, or CQ3 class of admission (for Special Immigrant Conditional Permanent Residents and Non-SI Parolees)

- Special Immigrant Parolees and Non-Special Immigrant Afghan Parolees
 - Form I-94 with the following notation:

 - Form I-766, Employment Authorization Document (EAD) with C11 Parolee category
 - Foreign passport with Customs and Border Patrol “PAROLED” stamp
- MRIV (machine readable immigrant visa) with holder’s unexpired passport, that contains the statement “upon endorsement serves as temporary I-551 evidencing permanent residence for 1 year”
- United States Travel Document (mint green cover), that contains the statement “Permit to Reenter Form I-327”
- INS Form G-639 (if citizen of Micronesia, Palau, or Republic of the Marshall Islands)
