Information Regarding Reporting Marital Status and Parent Determination

If that parent is remarried as of the date you filed FAFSA, both parent and stepparent must complete FAFSA.
- If both parents provided an exact equal amount of your financial support, or if neither parent supports you financially, your parent for FAFSA purpose is the parent with the greater income and/or assets as of the date you filed your 2026-27 FAFSA. If that parent is remarried as of the date you filed FAFSA, both parent and stepparent must complete FAFSA.
- If your legal parents are unmarried and living together, both parents must complete FAFSA.
- If your parent was widowed and has remarried as of the date you filed FAFSA, both parent and stepparent must complete FAFSA.
