## Scholarship Terms and Conditions for any Donor and Endowed Institutional Scholarship

To determine if your scholarship is a donor or endowed institutional scholarship covered under these terms and conditions. Please check the [UT Scholarship Portal](#) to see if it is listed.

1. The awarded scholarship begins in the fall semester, unless that is a summer semester, then the student will need to complete a summer aid application. It is not guaranteed that the student may use it for the summer, but the request can be provided. It is up to the awarding committee and the criteria for the donor scholarship. Students must be enrolled and attend each semester the semester is awarded. The award must be used for consecutive semesters.
2. The maximum length of this scholarship is two (2) semesters. Some scholarships may only be awarded for one semester. This is determined by the donor's agreement with the university.
3. One-half of the yearly award will be applied to the student's bill each fall and spring semester to help pay for any university charges. Some donor scholarships may be restricted to tuition and general fees. It is encouraged to review the criteria of the restrictions of the scholarship.
4. This scholarship will be used toward the payment of costs incurred at The University of Toledo and is not transferable to any other college or university.
5. Please note the amount and continuation of your scholarship is subject to change. If any such changes are necessary, you will be notified in writing via your UToledo email address.
6. Academic year requirements for scholarship recipients enrolled in degree programs that require a mandatory co-op or internship experience will be adjusted as needed. Students will need to contact the Scholarship Office at [utscholarships@utoledo.edu](mailto:utscholarships@utoledo.edu).
