Scholarship Terms and Conditions for the Online Out-of-State Award

- 1. The awarded scholarship begins in the semester the student is accepted (unless that is summer semester; then the student will need to complete a summer aid application, otherwise, the scholarship will begin in the fall semester.) Students may be enrolled and attend on a full-time or part-time basis each semester. The award must be used for consecutive semesters.
- 2. One-half of the yearly award will be applied to the student's bill each fall and spring semester to help pay for the out-of-state surcharge (up to 18 credit hours per semester). This award is subject to the availability of funds. Additional awards of other grants, scholarships, or benefits restricted to the OOS surcharge may reduce the amount of this scholarship. This scholarship is considered non-refundable.
- 3. This scholarship will be used toward the payment of costs incurred at The University of Toledo and is not transferable to any other college or university.
- 4. This scholarship could be adjusted or rescinded if the student is a recipient of an athletic scholarship or any other award or resource covering the cost of the out-of-state surcharge.
- 5. Please note the amount and continuation of your scholarship is subject to change. If any such changes are necessary, you will be notified in writing via your UToledo email address.
- 6. This scholarship will be removed from a student's account if the student does not maintain enrollment in a 100% online program or if the student's residency changes.

7. Renewal Process:

- The academic year begins with the summer semester and ends with the spring semester.

 Annual review for renewal will be at the end of each spring term, unless placed on a term by term review.
- Students must maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA for the scholarship to be renewed.
- Renewal requirements are subject to change at any time. Notice would be provided through students' Rocket email accounts.
