The University of Toledo Scholarship Terms and Conditions for the Pharmacy Excellence Scholarship

- 1. The awarded scholarship begins in the semester the student is accepted (unless that is summer semester; then the students will need to complete a summer aid application, otherwise, the scholarship will begin in the fall semester). Students must be enrolled and attend on a full-time basis each semester the award is used (although see below for renewal requirements). The award must be used for consecutive semesters.
- 2. The maximum length of this scholarship is eight (8) semesters, not to exceed five consecutive calendar years or the completion of a baccalaureate degree, whichever comes first.
- 3. One-half of the yearly award will be applied to the student's bill each fall and spring semester to help pay for full-time tuition and general fee (up to 18 credit hours per semester). This award is subject to the availability of funds. Additional awards of other grants, scholarships, or benefits restricted to tuition and general fee may reduce the amount of this scholarship or may allow this scholarship to be applied to University room and board charges. This scholarship is considered non-refundable except for institutionally approved expenses including but not limited to study abroad.
- 4. This scholarship will be used toward the payment of costs incurred at The University of Toledo and is not transferable to any other college or university.
- 5. Please note the amount and continuation of your scholarship is subject to change. If any such changes are necessary, you will be notified in writing via your UToledo email address.
- 6. Changing to a major not included in the College of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences would result in the loss of the Pharmacy Excellence Scholarship.
- 7. Renewal requirements for the Pharmacy Excellence Scholarship include maintaining a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5 and earning a minimum of 30 UT credit hours within two semesters of the academic year.
 - The academic year begins with the summer semester and ends with the spring semester. Annual review for renewal will be at the end of each spring term, unless placed on a term by term review.
 - Exceptions to these parameters may be reviewed individually for students who provide documentation regarding special circumstances.
 - Renewal requirements are subject to change at any time. Notice would be provided through students' Rocket email accounts.
