Scholarship Terms and Conditions for the Rocket Advantage Grant I, Rocket Advantage Grant II, and Rocket Advantage Grant for Continuing Students

- 1. The awarded grant begins in the fall semester. Students must be enrolled and attend on a full-time basis each semester the award is used. The award must be used for consecutive semesters.
- 2. The length of this grant is two (2) semesters each year that it is awarded. Recipients may receive this grant for a maximum of eight (8) semesters.
- 3. One-half of the yearly award will be applied to the student's bill for the fall and spring semester to help pay for full-time tuition and general fee (up to 18 credit hours per semester). The value of this award is subject to the availability of funds. Additional awards of other grants, scholarships, or benefits restricted to tuition and general fee may reduce the amount of this grant or may allow this grant to be applied to University room and board charges. Because this grant is awarded based in part on a student's estimated charges, any changes to the estimated charges may result in a reduction of the amount of this grant. This grant is considered non-refundable.
- 4. This grant will be used toward the payment of costs incurred at The University of Toledo and is not transferable to any other college or university.
- 5. This grant may be adjusted or rescinded if the student is a recipient of an athletic scholarship.
- 6. Please note the amount and continuation of your grant is subject to change. If any such changes are necessary, you will be notified in writing via your UToledo email address.
- 7. This grant is not automatically renewable. In addition to academic criteria, students must submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) each year by May 1 in order to be reviewed for eligibility.
