## The University of Toledo Scholarship Terms and Conditions for UT Achievement Award

- 1. The awarded scholarship begins in the semester the student is accepted (unless that is summer semester; then the student will need to complete a summer aid application, otherwise, the scholarship will begin in the fall semester). Students must be enrolled and attend on a full-time basis each semester the award is used (although see below for renewal requirements). The award must be used for consecutive semesters.
- 2. The maximum length of this scholarship is determined by the Semesters of Scholarship Eligibility Grid after all official transcripts have been received and does not exceed five consecutive calendar years or the completion of a baccalaureate degree, whichever comes first.

- 3. One-half of the yearly award will be applied to the student's bill each fall and spring semester to help pay for full-time tuition and general fee (up to 18 credit hours per semester). This award is subject to the availability of funds. Additional awards of other grants, scholarships, or benefits restricted to tuition and general fee may reduce the amount of this scholarship or may allow this scholarship to be applied to University room and board charges. This scholarship is considered non-refundable except for institutionally approved expenses including but not limited to study abroad.
- 4. This scholarship will be used toward the payment of costs incurred at The University of Toledo and is not transferable to any other college or university.
- 5. This scholarship could be adjusted or rescinded if the student is a recipient of an athletic scholarship.
- 6. Please note the amount and continuation of your scholarship is subject to change. If any such changes are necessary, you will be notified in writing via your UToledo email address.
- 7. Academic year requirements for scholarship recipients enrolled in degree programs that require a mandatory co-op or internship experience will be adjusted as needed. Students will need to contact the Scholarship Office at *utscholarships@utoledo.edu*.

## 8. Renewal Process:

The academic year begins with the summer semester and ends with the spring semester. The annual review of renewable scholarships occurs at the end of each spring term.

Your scholarship is automatically renewed if you have remaining semesters of eligibility and you meet each of the following requirements:

- 1. Successfully complete a minimum of 67% of the credit hours you attempt each semester
- 2. Maintain a 2.0 or higher cumulative grade point average (GPA)
- 3. Finish your degree in a period no longer than 150% of the published length of your program

The maximum allowable time frame for an undergraduate student is:

- 186 credit hours for a bachelor's degree
- 99 credit hours for an associate's degree
- 45 credit hours for a certificate

If you do not meet the renewal requirements listed above, you will receive an email informing you that your scholarship has been cancelled. The email will include instructions on how to appeal the cancellation of your scholarship due to documentable extenuating circumstances.

Appealable circumstances may include situations such as death of a relative, an injury or illness, or other special circumstance.

Renewal requirements are subject to change at any time. Notice will be provided via email to your Rockets email account.
