Comments/Notes: The Higher Education Diversity Certificate at the master's level will remain a 12 credit certificate but will move from three 4-credit courses to four 3-credit courses. The content, readings, learning objectives, assignments, and exams remain the same but are now distributed across 4 courses instead of 3 courses. The Certificate will be offered over 4 semesters instead of the current 2 semesters plus

Rationale:

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The rationale for this change stems from (a) a request by the College of Graduate Studies to reconsider the credit distribution across courses and (b) low demand for summer courses.

(a) Given that many of the students who enroll in the Diversity Certificate courses are graduate assistants, this move responds to the students' concern that this 4 credit course, among their usual 3 credit courses, brings total semester credit hours to one more than the 9 credits that are provided for by graduate assistantships and raises the issue of ability to pay.

(b) Enrollment is very strong for fall and spring classes. However, we found that summer courses experienced low enrollments for reasons that include graduate assistantships not covering summer enrollment. This change allows students to complete the certificate during fall and spring semesters while they are on assistantships.
