For the MA, students used to take 1 of 4 required classes during that year. Now they will take 2 of 4 of those classes during their MA year. These may include one of the following 3credit hour courses: EDP 5/7240, COUN 7160, or SPSY 6260. CPR 2.17.17

#### Rationale:

This proposed change is the result of examining our school psychology program course sequence and moving some courses from the MA to the EdS years of the program. We are moving two courses, SPSY 5310/7310 and SPSY 7180 from the MA to the Eds degree. There is no change to any course content. The 4 hour reduction in the MA is recaptured as part of the EdS program. As a reminder, our program is a three year graduate program. Students receive a MA and EdS degree. Both are required in order to be licensed as a school psychologist.
