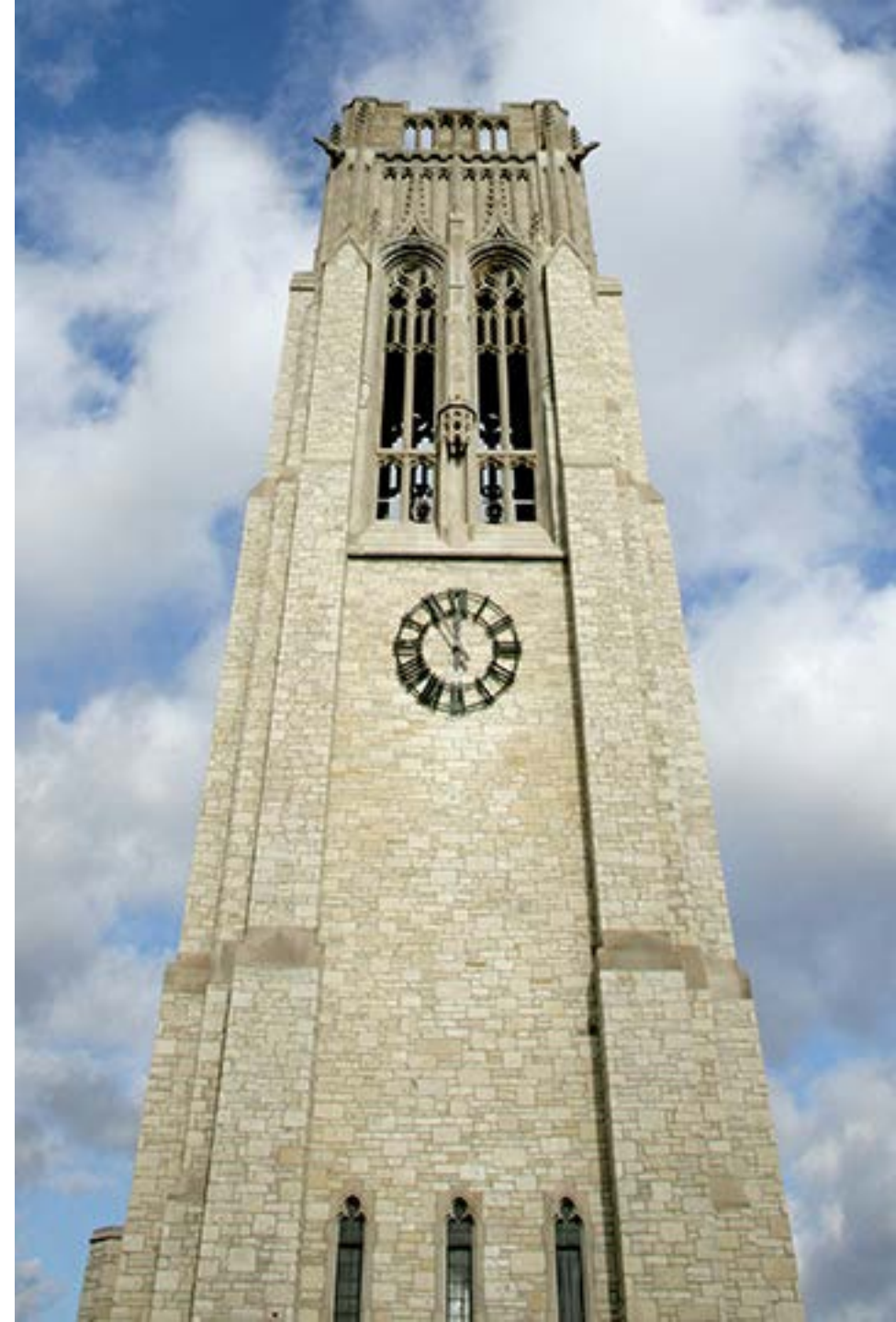

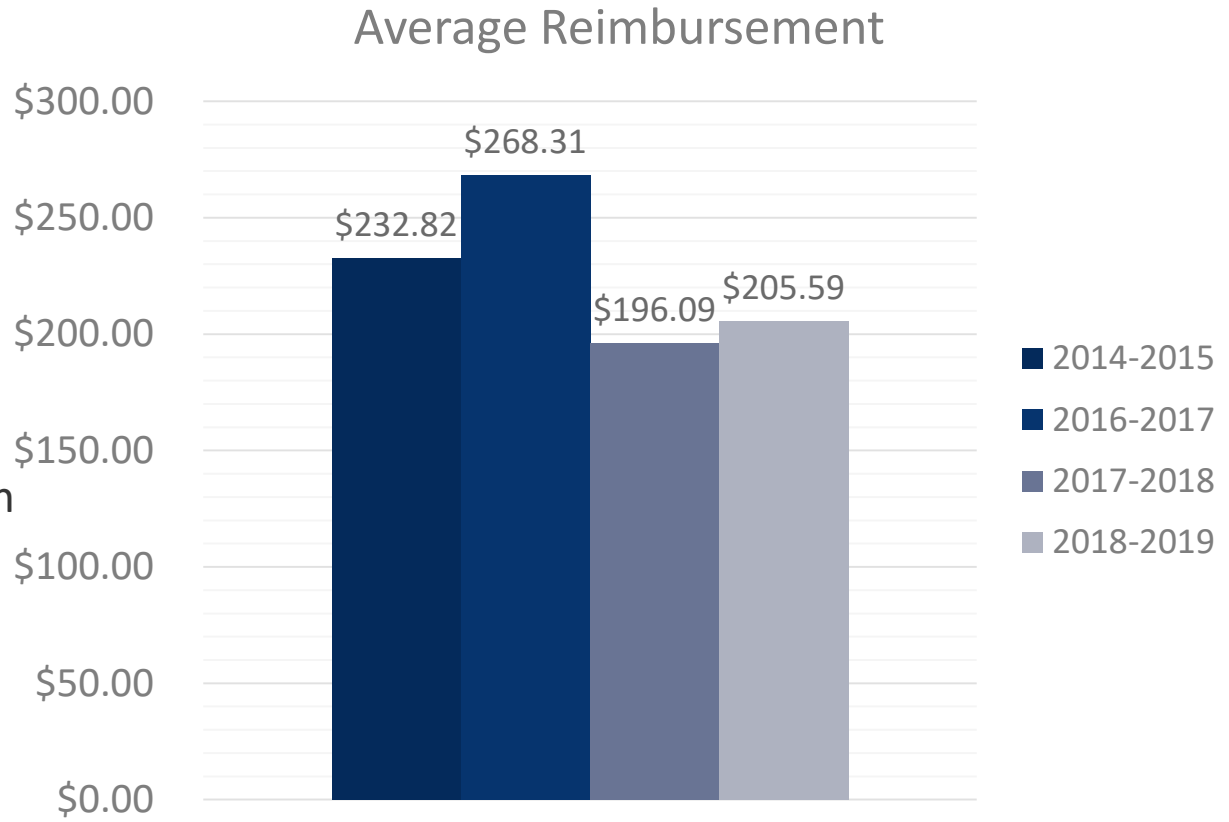
- 200+ individuals in attendance from 20+ universities

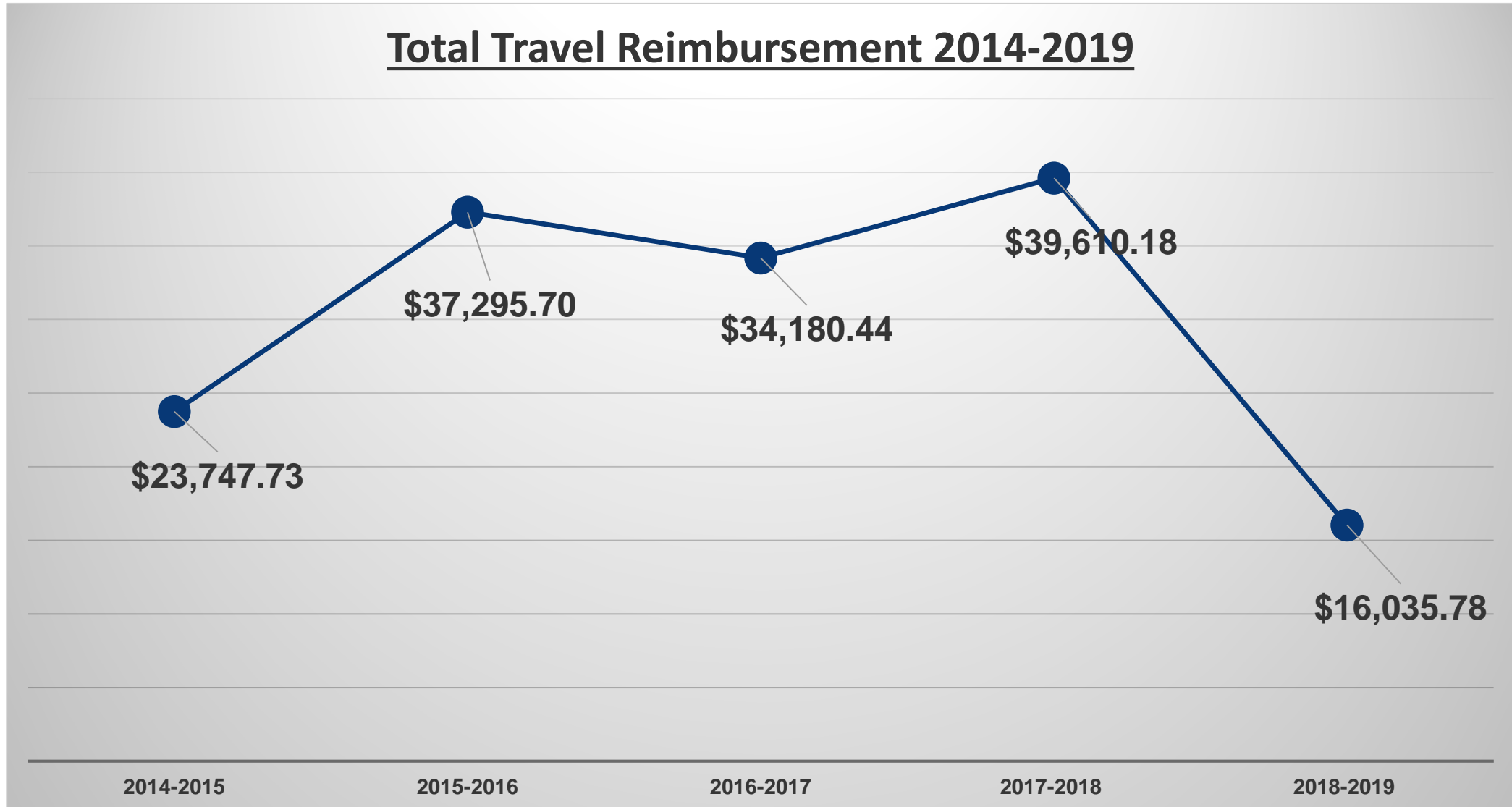


Travel Reimbursement

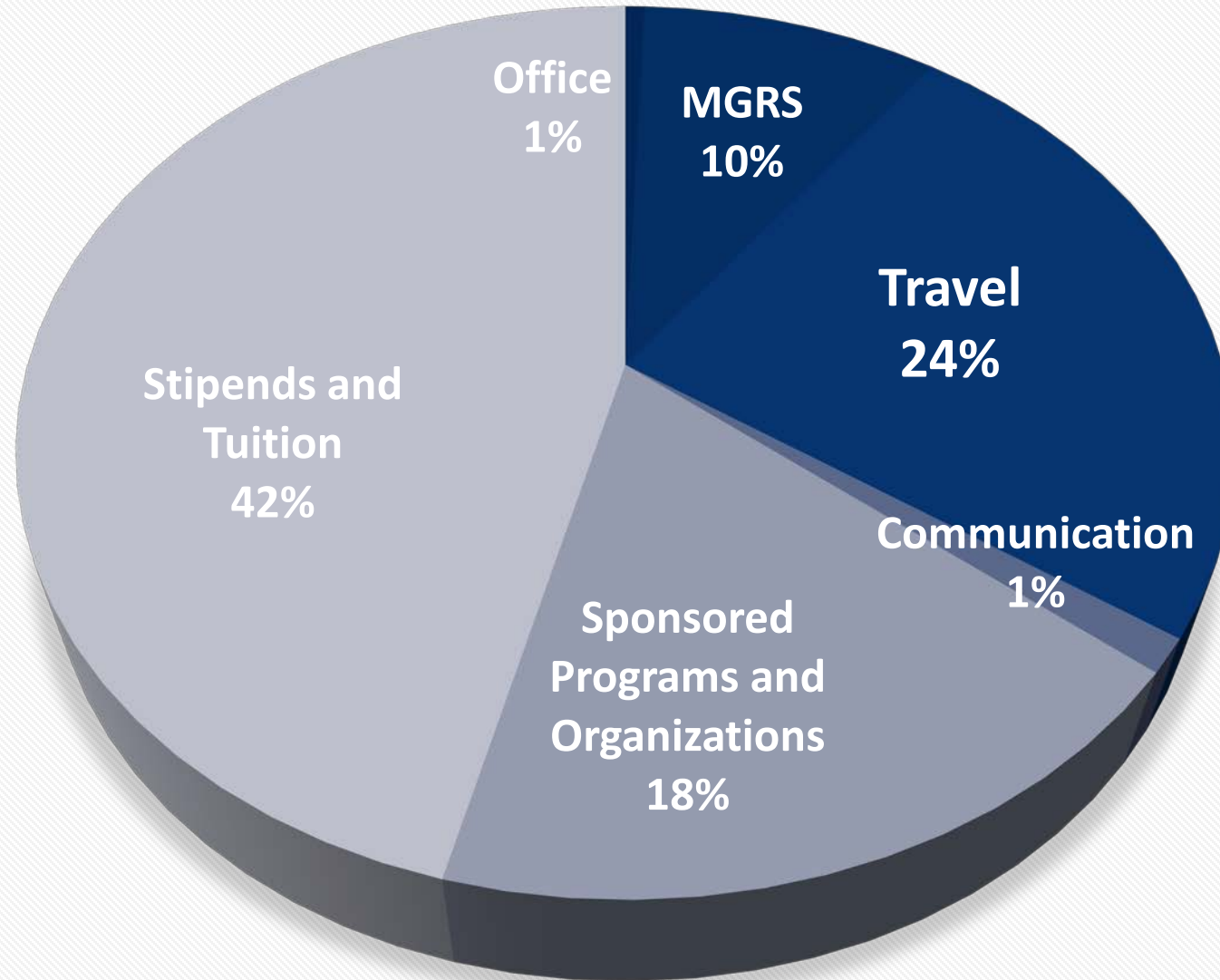
- 2016-2017 average reimbursement was \$217.71
- 2017-2018 average reimbursement was \$196.09
 - 202 Approved Applicants
- 2018-2019 average reimbursement was \$205.59
 - 78 Approved Applicants
 - 123 Pre-Travel Applicants total
 - Includes some that will be processed over summer
 - 2 Large Group (over 5 people) approved applicants
 - Less than previous year
 - Anticipate MGRS volunteers and members to use through summer
- 2019-2020 Projection
 - Maintain at about the same >\$200 average reimbursement
 - Reimburse >150 students



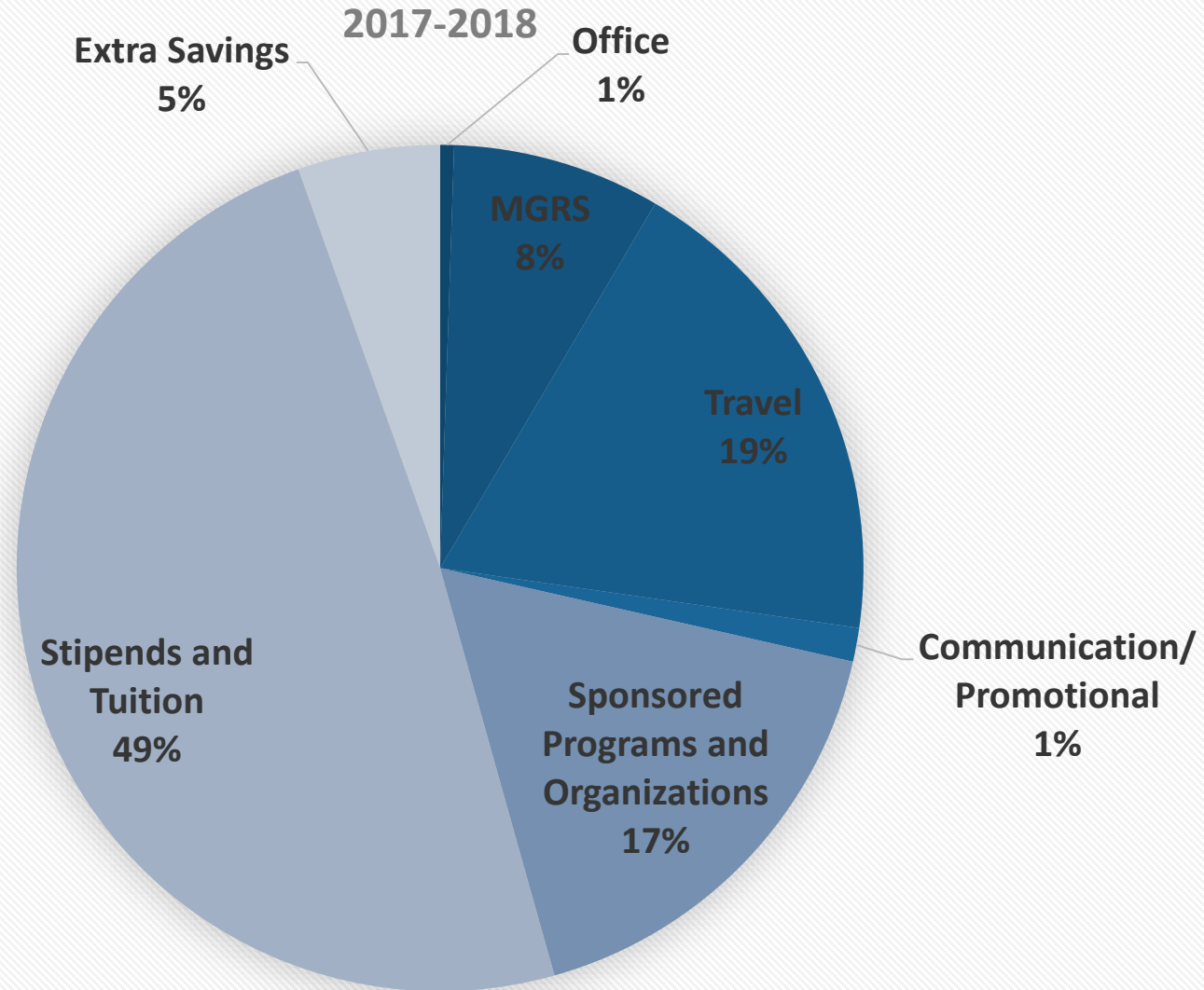
Travel Reimbursement Trends



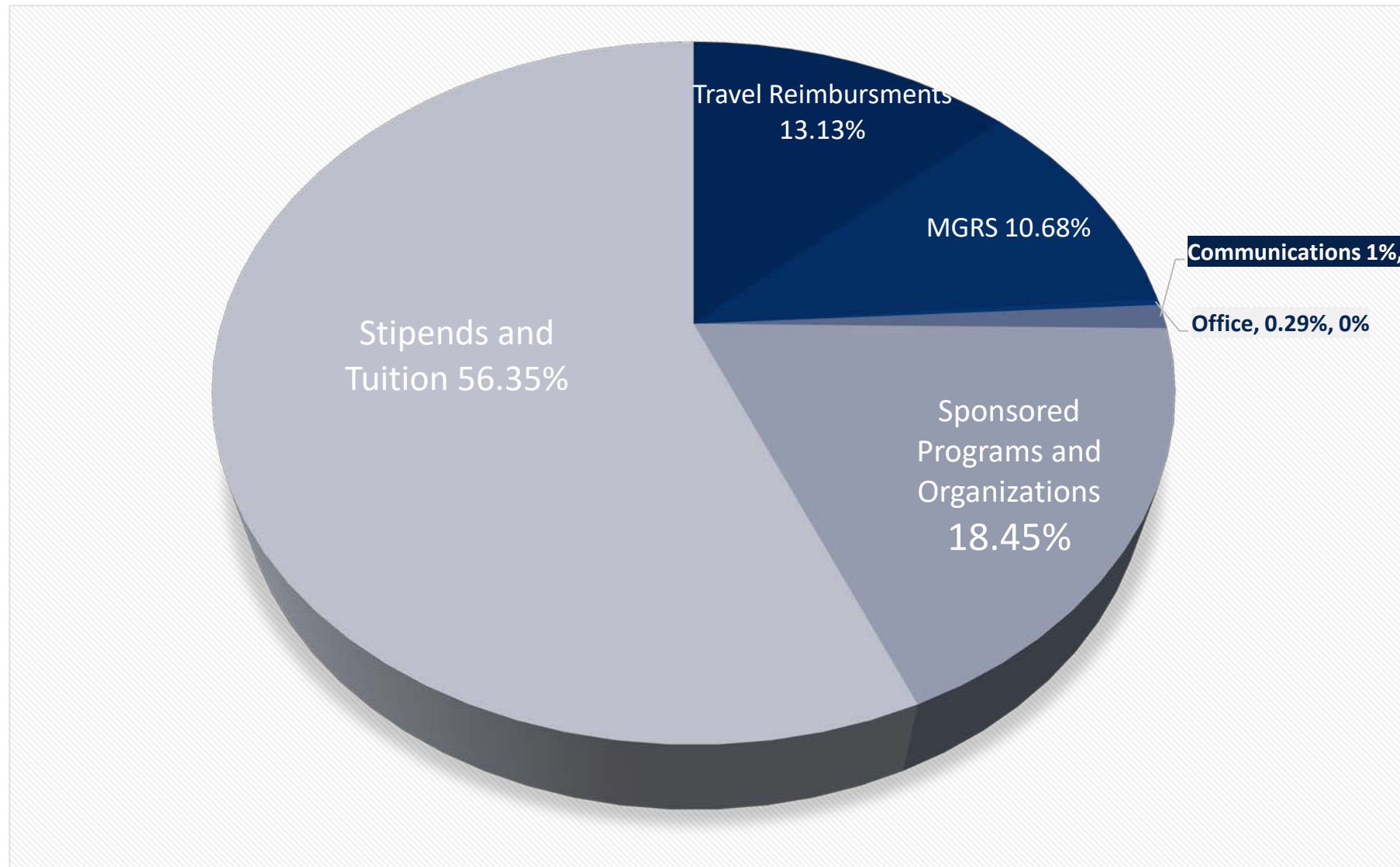
2016-17 Budget

2018-19 Officer Tuition and Stipend

- 4% reduction in officer stipend/tuition from 2016/17-2017/18
- **Fixed** dollar amounts for the tuition & fees for Executive Board
 - **President:** \$11,500 stipend + \$11,500 tuition + \$500 fees = \$23,500
 - **Vice President:** \$8,000 stipend + \$7,700 tuition = \$15,700
 - **Treasurer:** \$6,500 stipend, \$7,700 tuition = \$14,200
 - **HSC Secretary:** \$1,850 stipend, \$200 tuition (\$100/semester) = \$2,050
 - **MC Secretary:** \$1,850 stipend, \$200 tuition (\$100/semester) = \$2,050
 - **Communication Specialist:** \$1,500 stipend, \$200 tuition (\$100/semester) = \$1,700
