It is CRITICAL to become familiar with Blackboard early in your academic career here at UT.

During/after meeting with your academic advisor, this is where you will register for classes.

If you have health insurance coverage (your own policy or as a dependent), you can waive UT's plan annually.

If you are bringing a vehicle to campus, you will need to request a parking permit each semester.

The \$10.00 Legal Services Fee can be waived. We recommend you consider keeping this valuable service.

The Student Green Fund is an optional "opt-in" student run initiative. If you choose to add the \$5.00 fee, it will be added to your student account.

Both the "Detail" and "Week at a Glance" schedules are useful tools to view your registered courses.

Be sure to check your bill regularly, and make payments by payment deadlines. If you are unable to pay your bill in full, you may sign up for the Installment Payment Plan. This will divide your bill into manageable monthly payments during the semester (additional fee included).

FERPA protects the privacy of your educational records. Click here to give UT consent to share account billing/financial information to select individuals.

Authorizing Title IV will ensure financial aid is properly applied to your account (one-time authorization).

Any excess financial aid can be deposited into your bank account or transferred to your Rocket Card (\$800 maximum).

If you plan to live on campus, be sure to apply for housing. The housing portal will also allow you to search for and select your room and roommates.

The Degree Audit is a report that matches degree requirements for your intended major with courses you have already taken (including transfer and post-secondary coursework). Run audits regularly to keep track of your progress toward your degree.

UT students are permitted to print official enrollment verifications free of charge.

Fill out the FAFSA form to apply for financial aid (www.fafsa.ed.gov).

If you are selected for verification, return all requested documents ASAP.

Once your FAFSA is processed, you will be able to accept/decline financial aid. Scholarships and grants are automatically applied to your account.

Before accepting aid, you need to consider your budget. Only accept the aid you need to cover expenses (school, books, housing).

After accepting aid, complete Loan Entrance Counseling and sign the Master Promissory note.

Only Student Loans can be accepted online. Parent PLUS loans require an additional application.

Be sure to watch all tutorial videos for clarification.

Be sure to upload a photo and order your Rocket Card (UT's Student ID Card). There is a \$35.00 fee for new/replacement cards.

Keep your personal contact information (address, phone number etc.) updated at all times.

UT ALERT is an Emergency
