



The College of Graduate Studies is pleased to announce that OhioLINK is implementing a field for ORCID Identifiers in the OhioLINK Electronic Theses and Dissertations (ETD) Center.

As an open, nonprofit effort to create and maintain a registry of unique researcher identifiers, ORCID provides a transparent method of linking research activities and outputs to these identifiers. ORCID is a hub that connects researchers and research through the embedding of ORCID identifiers in key workflows, such as research profile maintenance, manuscript submissions, grant applications, and patent applications.

We encourage you to take advantage of this valuable addition to the ETD Center, because it facilitates your creation of a unique identifier early in your research career. An ORCID Identifier provides you with a way to manage the records of your intellectual activities, while also distinguishing your works from others with a similar name.

To create your own ORCID identifier, simply go to <https://orcid.org/register> and complete the brief form. You can continue to build your profile and add scholarly works as you move forward in your career. You can also sign up during the ETD submission process, and the directions follow this introduction.

ORCID Identifiers in the ETD Center

As of March 11th, 2015, ORCID Identifiers are now integrated into the OhioLINK ETD Center for use by submitters to add to their accounts. ORCID Identifiers help distinguish one researcher from another, especially when names are similar, and serve as an online profile that can link to a researcher's works, funding, professional website, and other useful information. For any questions, issues, or concerns, please contact your local graduate school office for help.

Adding an ORCID id during sign-up

When signing up for a submitter account, the ORCID Identifier box appears on the sign-up form. If the submitter already has an ORCID, it can be copied and pasted into the box or typed in.

Once the submitter clicks elsewhere on the form, such as filling out another box, the system will check ORCID to ensure that it is valid and display who it belongs to on the far right so that a submitter can confirm that it is the correct one.

The second option during sign-up is to click the “Create ORCID” button which will open a new tab and load <https://orcid.org/register> for the submitter to register on ORCID’s website and once complete the submitter can finish the ETD Center sign-up by entering the new ORCID Identifier.

As a third option, submitters who have an ORCID Identifier can search for it. Once they have typed their first and last name into the sign-up boxes, clicking “Find Existing ORCID” will open a new tab and load search results in ORCID based on their name. The submitter can then enter it and complete sign-up.

Adding an ORCID Identifier to an existing submitter's profile

For submitters who did not add an ORCID during the sign-up process, they can add one to their profiles by logging into the ETD Center and clicking the "Go to Profile" button. The profile will load and is similar to the sign-up form with the same options as above for the submitter to create, find, or enter an ORCID Identifier. On the profile page, click "Save All Changes" once entered. The ORCID box will not appear on the submitter homepage once an ORCID Identifier is associated with the account.
