<p>Impact on student learning: The Jasper Woodbury series is one of the most innovative uses of technology for helping students experience “real world” mathematical problem solving, reasoning, and critical thinking. These “episodes” of real world problems were originally created in Laserdisc format (the math ed faculty have 6 of the original Laserdisc versions and these were used extensively in the courses listed above) and have recently been reformatted on CD’s. These are the types of mathematical experiences that are detailed in the new Ohio Common Core Mathematics Standards and demonstrate the instructional strategies that our undergraduate and graduate students must understand and be able to use in their classrooms to help students learn mathematics.</p>
