The bodies are used as exhibits during several mock crime scenes throughout the semester. The classes are design utilizing build blocks or phases where the students are given pieces of information regarding a particular crime and they are asked to investigate that situation using the skills they were taught. The students use the reconstruction techniques to develop a likely sequence of events at the crime scene by observing and evaluating physical evidence. The bodies provide a more realistic view regarding crime scene investigations.

The field of Crime Scene Investigation and Reconstruction is an ever evolving field of the Criminal Justice system. These Forensic Bodies are an essential piece in the utilization of current and future criminal justice technology.
