The TLE TeachLivETM Lab is a mixed-reality teaching environment that supports teacher practice in pedagogy and content. In the TLE TeachLivETM Lab, pre-service and in-service teachers walk into a simulated middle-school classroom where the room is real but the students are digital avatars. The virtual students controlled by real trainers are made to act like typical (or atypical) pre-teens, depending on the objectives of the experience. Each student's personality is based upon those typically encountered in a middle school classroom.

The TeachLivETM Lab, developed at the University of Central Florida, is currently being delivered to ten campuses in the United States. TLE TeachLivETM participants can interact with virtual students and review previous work; present new content to students; provide scaffolding or guided practice in a variety of content areas; and monitor students while they work independently.

Ongoing expense would be to pay for the \$120/hour use cost of the Simulation Center.
