It will be housed in the newly available interrogation/lab space for the criminal justice program. The system includes digital cameras, microphones, and recording and playback equipment.

Briefly describe how the technology will be used (function)*: This system will be used to simulate real life forensic interviews and interrogation situations. It will be used to teach required investigative skills, and provide imperative practical experience. Additionally, the students will use this system to view feedback from their videos and others. The field of Investigative Process is an ever-evolving field in the criminal justice system and this equipment is a valuable tool in the experiential learning process. It will also serve to support the student's development in the ever evolving and growing advocacy program attached to the criminal justice program.

Provide a rationale that Tech Fee funds are appropriate for this request*:

This equipment will be used in the teaching of numerous students, in multiple course offerings. Multiple sections of Criminal Investigation I, Criminal Investigation II and Criminal Investigation III are taught every year, as well as the Child Advocacy Courses jointly taught in both the criminal justice and social work programs. They move beyond the form of instruction to the practical application of knowledge by the students, merging theory and practice in the classroom.

Scope of Work

RPC Video will install four IP based PoE pan/tilt/zoom camera systems on the third floor of the HH building. Two on the ceiling in room 3015 and two on the ceiling in room 3013. In addition to the cameras you will have a ceiling mount microphone that will provide an audio reinforcement for each of the cameras. Locations of the cameras and microphones are to be determined by the owner. Each camera/microphone combination will have a wall mounted switch that will allow you to start and stop the network recorder for each area. The network recorder will have a 3TB hard drive that will allow for at least a semester of A/V recordings. We will install a network recorder in your existing rack in room 3011. We will provide an 8 port PoE switch and install it in the same rack as the recorder to create a private network that includes the four cameras and a (owner provided) laptop computer that will be used to control the system.
