Provide a brief description of the technology requested*:

SimWriter® Professional is a simulation authoring tool that allows instructional designers to create interactive simulations of any decision-making process. Briefly describe how the technology will be used (function)*: The software will be used in two different ways. The first is the design and development of simulations that address issues and decisions frequently faced by school principals. The issues can involve students, teachers, parents and/or community members. Students are lead through a series of steps from flowcharting to online development that require them to think through a series of steps and decisions in order to address the problem.

The second area SimWriter® Professional will be used is to assist pre service principals practice making decisions related to the job of a school principal. The development and use of simulations provides an avenue for demonstration of leadership skills.
