They will be used to teach required investigative skills, and provide imperative practical experience, with the use of several other pieces of technology such as ultra violet lights, crime scene diagraming, and crime scene reports. Additionally the students will use the bodies to reconstruct crime scenes and engage in evidence collection and use them to engage in the investigative process. The field of Crime Scene Investigation and Reconstruction is an ever evolving field of the criminal justice system. These Forensic bodies are an integral part to using technology currently provided by the tech fee, and in the utilization of the current and future criminal justice technology.

These bodies will be used in the teaching of numerous students, in 4 separate course offerings. Multiple sections of Criminal Investigation I, Criminal Investigation III are taught every year as well as the Child Advocacy Courses jointly taught in both the criminal justice and social work programs. They are reusable and provide for a variety of practical learning experiences. They move beyond the form of instruction to the practical application of knowledge and technology by the students.
