Technologically-advanced adult, child and infant CPR manikins are designed with electronic components that provide students with auditory and visual feedback related to depth and rate of chest compressions. For example, the Prestan infant manikin includes a rate monitor to electronically evaluate cardiac compressions through a series of colored lights on the infant's body. These manikins are the future of CPR/AED training and meet the standards of the American Red Cross.

## Briefly describe how the technology will be used (function)\*:

The manikins will be used by undergraduate students for hands-on skill demonstration and evaluation in First Aid classes. Since First Aid is a required course for many majors, approximately 400 students will be using these manikins during the fall and spring semesters. These technologically-advanced manikins provide immediate auditory and visual feedback to students allowing them to readily make adjustments in their technique, learn and retain the skill longer and improve CPR outcomes.
