AAC refers to any type of low-, mid-, or high-tech support needed by an individual whose verbal abilities do not allow all of his/her communicative needs to be met. These devices give a "voice" to a student/client/patient, who due to a congenital, developmental, or acquired disorder, have limited verbal output.

Briefly describe how the technology will be used (function)*:

This tech fee would allow students to have hands-on experience with AAC assessment and intervention devices and tools that are discussed in class, especially in SLP 6550. Additionally, all SLP UG and G students have access to everything in the AAC lab up to approximately 20 hours per week to engage in self-study, device practice, trials with their clients, etc. Graduate SLP GAs have created self-study material for each AAC device that was previously purchased through Tech Fee (Spring 2018) to allow for self-guided student learning - and will also create training materials for these items.

Provide a rationale that Tech Fee funds are appropriate for this request*:

Tech Fee funds are appropriate for this request, as students have specifically requested this technology. The items on this request were compiled by several 2nd year graduate students who already completed SLP 6550 and were given the opportunity (by Dr. Diehm) to indicate which AAC devices and tools they would have liked to have first-hand practice with when enrolled in SLP 6550 or as a student clinician in our clinic. These requests are appropriate as it is expected that SLPs who enter the field are knowledgeable of currently available communication devices, supports, etc. for those who have complex communication needs (see information from our national organization here: https://www.asha.org/PRPSpecificTopic.aspx? folderid=8589942773§ion=Key Issues#Roles and Responsibilities.)
