Please be advised that in making accreditation decisions, the CACREP Board of Directors will use information from the institution's self-study (including any addenda), pertinent correspondence between the CACREP office and the program, the site review team's report, and the institution's response to the site review team's report. In addition, please be advised that according to Board policy, the institution has the right to withdraw any program from further review at any time during the accreditation process prior to a decision by the Board, through written communication with the CACREP office.
