GRADUATE ASSISTANTSHIP APPLICATION

MPH Students may apply for a Graduate Assistantship, which provides a stipend plus waiver of tuition. These are available on a very limited basis and the application process is competitive. Graduate Assistants are required to enroll for a minimum of twelve credit hours each semester and work for twenty hours each week. Assistantships are awarded for a twelve-month period, pending maintenance of a satisfactory grade point average. Students may be requested to reapply for Graduate Assistantship support after the twelve months.
