

Dragon - PowerMic Mobile app on IOS and Android device

Purpose – use your iPhone/iPad or Android device as your Dragon mic on a PC or in vlab (both Mac or PC)

Prerequisites

- ✓ **Dragon Medical One** – make sure this app is installed on your computer
- ✓ **PowerMic Mobile app** – download from the Apple Store or Google Play




Install Dragon Medical One

Skip to the next section, if it is already installed or if using vlab. See the icon on the right

1. **UT computers** – to install, open the “websites” folder in your desktop and double-click “Dragon Medical One”
2. **Personal computer (at home)**
 - a. **PC:** search for and open Internet Explorer 11, then copy and paste the link below. Click “Install Dragon Medical One” <http://dragonmedicalone.nuance.com/OneClick/index.htm?id=EEXD-1N39-A6>
 - b. **Mac:** use vlab to access Dragon Medical One. There is no Dragon software for Macs

Install Dragon PowerMic Mobile app (free)

1. Install the free app on your phone/tablet from the Apple Store or Google Play
2. When the app launches, tap this link to pull in your profile

 - a. **iPad/iPhone** – tap “IOS”
 - b. **Android** – tap “Android”
3. Type your utad username, when prompted



Log into Dragon Medical One

1. From your desktop (UT PC or in vlab), launch Dragon Medical One
2. Type your utad username on the computer. Launch the Mobile app
3. The app will automatically connect to Dragon Medical One
4. Tap the microphone icon in the app to dictate! Tap it again to turn it off.

Dragon Mobile App icons

1. **Dictation box:** tap the upper left icon to open dictation box. Tap “T->” to transfer your text e.g. into the EMR
2. **Dictate:** tap the green microphone icon. To turn off the mic, tap it again
3. **Navigating within Commands:** the bottom arrows are “next field” (right) and “previous field” (left). The check mark at the top is “accept defaults”
