


## Patient Handoff Tool (PHT) – Clear Discharge Follow-ups List

### SHORT VERSION

- ⊕ Patients tagged as “Discharge Complete” drop off PHT list immediately
- ⊕ **The problem** – ‘Discharge Follow-up’ patients, however, remain on PHT. IT cannot to delete the patients
- ⊕ **The solution**
  - Residents must switch the patient from “Follow-up” status to “Discharge Complete”
  - The patient drops off PHT’s “Follow-up” list immediately

### DETAILED VERSION

- ⊕ As of March 29<sup>th</sup>, 2017, here’s how many patients are still listed as “Discharge follow-up” on PHT

- ⊕ Once all discharge requirements are completed, the resident must go back to PHT, click “Follow-up” tab, locate patient and click “Discharge Complete”
- ⊕ Unfortunately, per current policy, IT is not permitted to go in and delete the patients on residents’ behalf
