Click the network link on the bottom right of your taskbar



Choose UTGuest and click “Connect”

Guest Wireless Network

University of Toledo's open wireless networks allow the University of Toledo the opportunity to provide its intended community with non-critical, wireless connectivity, but only as a convenience and only with limited technical support. Authorized University of Toledo Information Services personnel and automated tools may disconnect at any time, without notice, any connection to University of Toledo's wireless networks or from a wireless network device that poses a threat to the security of University of Toledo's networks or University of Toledo's Computerized Information Assets. Also, the University of Toledo may block or restrict wireless access to inappropriate resources we are aware of (including some web sites) and all users of the University of Toledo's open wireless networks are expected to behave in an exemplary manner (including conforming to reasonable norms of behavior, respecting the sensibilities and privacy of others, not disrupting or offending others, closing or stopping use of the University of Toledo's open wireless services or resources if asked to do so, and more).
