

Parks Tower Wireless Network for Gaming Devices

Information Technology is piloting a new wireless network SSID for gaming devices in Parks Tower.

- Users are invited to enroll their wireless enabled gaming devices at <https://clearpass.utoledo.edu/guest>
 - This can only be done from a computer/mobile device that is connect to ResNet.
- After enrollment they can then connect their gaming device to the SSID **UTGaming_PT_Demo**
- **At this time only** gaming devices from **Microsoft, Nintendo** and **Sony** (i.e. Nintendo Switch, Microsoft Xbox and/or Sony PlayStation) will be permitted onto this wireless network.

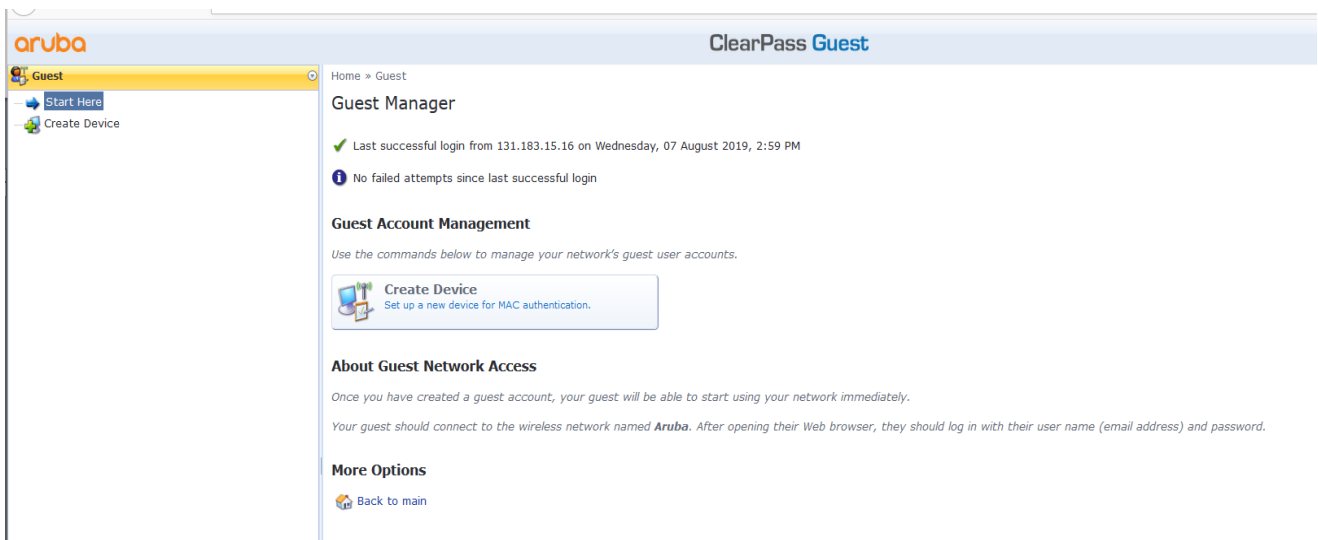
Part 1: Enrolling Gaming Systems in ClearPass

1. Visit clearpass.utoledo.edu/guest from a computer/phone that is on **ResNet** wired or wireless
2. Log in with your UTAD username ((ex. Jsmith4)) and Password

4. Fill in the information requested in the fields
 - a. **Device Name**-A name to identify the device
 - b. **MAC Address** of Gaming System (Please call the ITHelpDesk 419.530.2400 for assistance in locating your MAC address)
