#### **Advanced Research and Writing Sections – Spring 2026**

Each fall and spring semester every faculty member who is not on leave will offer a section of Advanced Research and Writing. Listed below are the topics on which each faculty member is prepared to supervise student papers for Spring 2026.

Ordinarily, if there is a substantive course offered in the subject area in which you wish to write a paper for Advanced Research and Writing, you must 1) have completed that course, or 2) be concurrently enrolled in that course, or 3) receive the prior permission of the instructor. Some instructors may require completion of that course and not just concurrent enrollment. To determine the requirements for a particular section, or to clarify its topics, you should contact the instructor before registering.

<u>Each section will have a limited enrollment, and once that limit is reached that section will be closed</u>. If your first choice for a section is closed, enrolling for Advanced Research and Writing in Spring 2025 would require selecting another section. If you wish to work only with a particular professor or professors and their sections are closed this spring, you will have to wait for a later semester. Registration takes place online through the ordinary registration process.
