Pro Se Divorce Clinic

Family Court, 429 N Michigan, Toledo

Fridays, 1:30 p.m. – 3:30 p.m. (dates are scheduled as needed)

Assist clients with forms for filing pro se divorces with no minor children. Forms are completed during a group session (led by attorney). Assist the program with preparing the paperwork to be filed.

Pro Se Juvenile Clinic

1st and 3rd Thursdays, 11:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.

Assist clients with a variety of forms, including change of custody, modification of child support, grandparents' rights, visitation issues, establishing paternity, and others. How-to manuals provided, but some clients need individual help with pro se forms.

2nd Chance Tuesday Expungement Clinic

2nd Tuesday of each month, 1:00 p.m. – 2:30 p.m.

Read clients' records or recidivist reports to determine eligibility. How-to manuals are provided. Assist clients with filling out pro se forms to seal their record.

Pro Se Guardianship Program

Meetings are scheduled at student's convenience, estimated 1 hour meeting

Assist clients in filing pro se guardianships using the Probate Court's website for pleadings. Forms are completed during the meeting and clients file upon leaving the office.

Veterans Brief Advice Clinic

1st Thursday of each month, 8:30 am. – 11:00 a.m.

Assist volunteer attorneys with meeting with veterans to give brief legal advice on variety of legal issues. Law students will not be giving legal advice, but can sit with volunteer attorneys and help with other aspects of the clinic.
