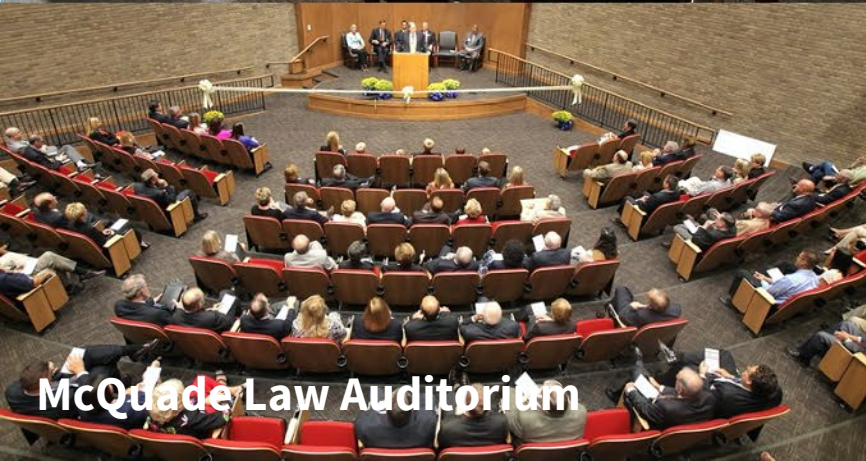

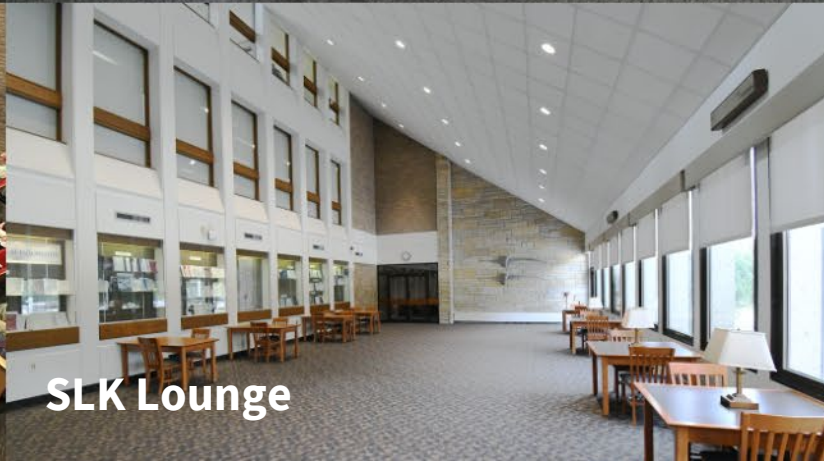

# COURSE OF STUDY OPTIONS

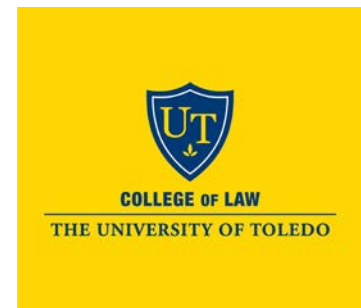
**Full-time J.D.** – 3 years

**Part-time J.D.** – 4 years / flexible day or evening

**Two-Year J.D.** – only for lawyers trained outside U.S.

**3+3 Program** – 6 years for bachelor's degree + J.D.

*January and August start dates!*



# FIRST-YEAR COURSES

For full- and part-time J.D., you only need **89 credit hours to graduate.**

Required first-year courses provide a **strong foundation** in core legal subjects.

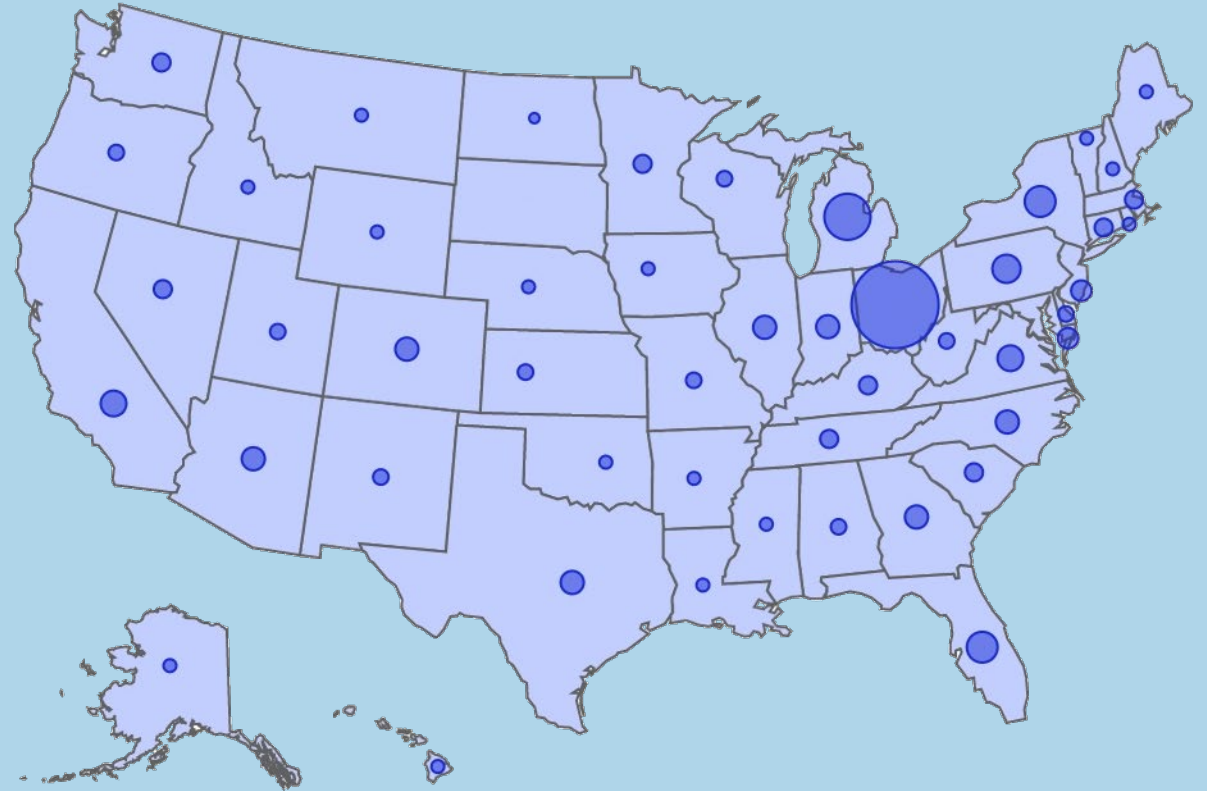

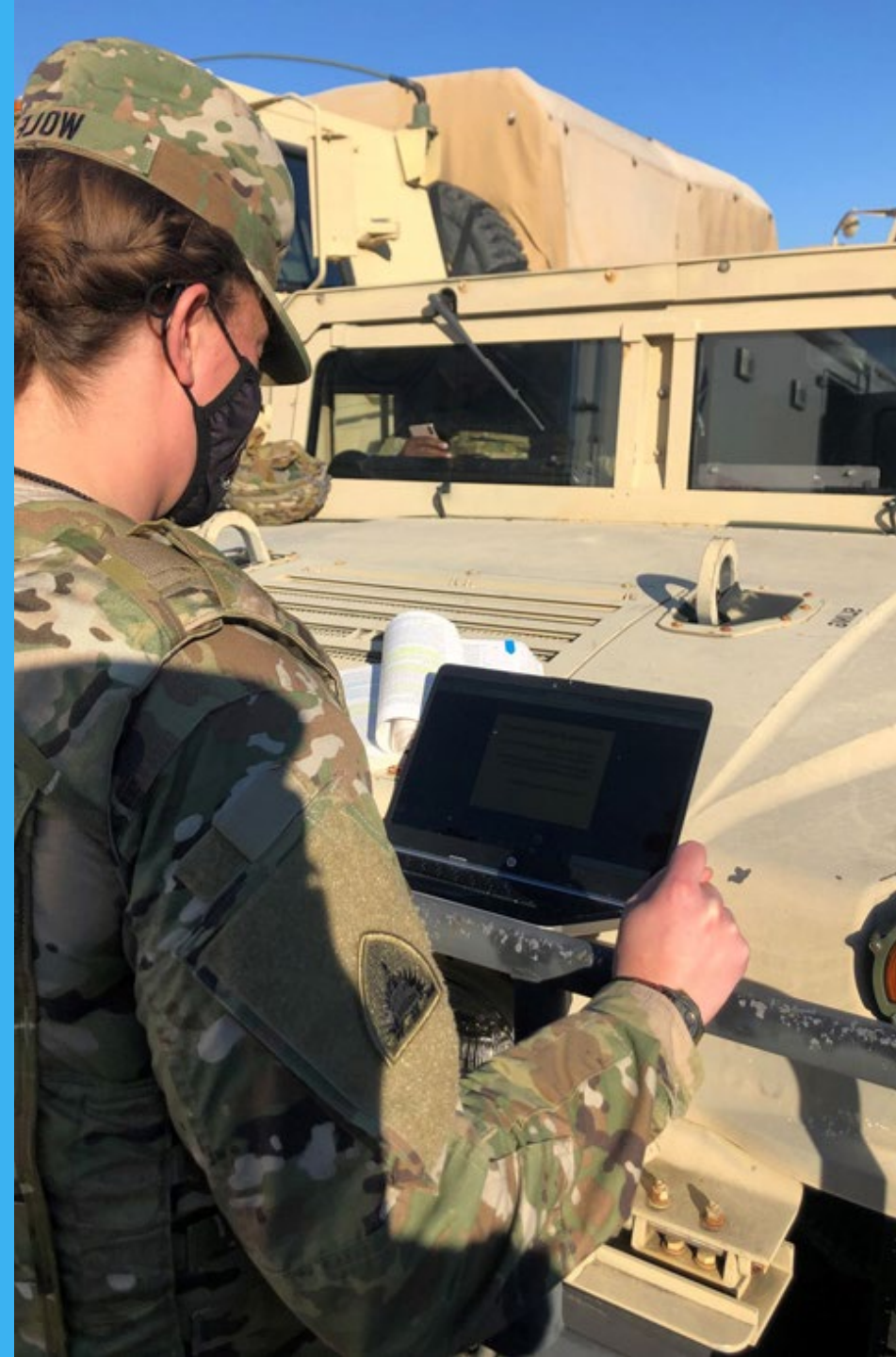

# TUITION & COST OF LIVING

- Lowest tuition among law schools in the region
- In-state and out-of-state students pay the same affordable tuition rates – under \$22,000 per academic year
- \$100 per semester out-of-state surcharge
- Lowest cost of living in the region





# SCHOLARSHIPS

- Over \$1.5M in entering student scholarships
- Non-conditional scholarships
- Full- and partial-tuition scholarships for highly qualified students
- No separate application



# FINANCIAL AID

- Complete FAFSA to apply for federal student aid
- Loan Options
  - Direct Unsubsidized Loan (federal) – *Up to \$20,500 per academic year*
  - Direct Grad PLUS Loan (federal) – *Up to cost of attendance*
  - Alternative loans (private)
- Federal Work-Study starting 2L year

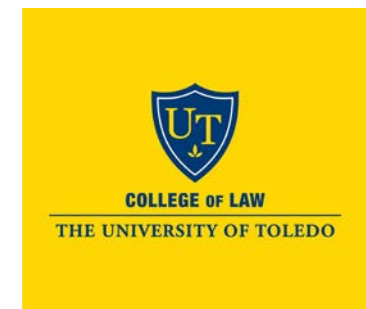

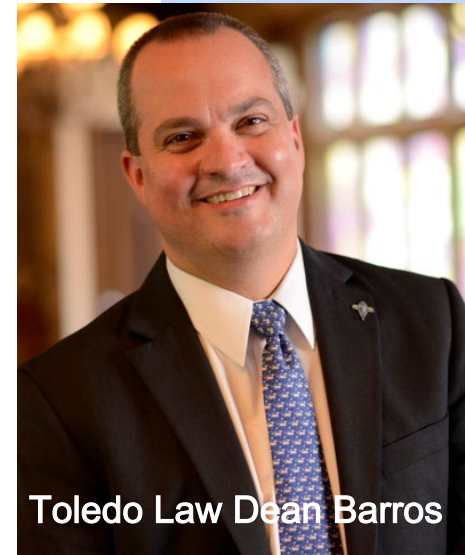

# APPLY FOR FALL 2021

- Start classes this August
- Application deadline: **Aug. 1, 2021**
- LSAT accepted: June 2021 or earlier





# APPLY FOR SPRING OR FALL 2022

- Start classes next year in January or August
- Online applications open Sep. 15, 2021
- Application deadlines
  - **Nov. 15, 2021** for spring start
  - **Aug. 1, 2022** for fall start
- LSAT accepted:
  - October 2021 or earlier for spring start
  - June 2022 or earlier for fall start
