Academic Computing Steering Committee: Recommends to Computer Policy Committee on academic computing; computing needs of students, faculty, and staff; service levels; computing service; and recommends project priorities for the Manager of User Services.

Administrative Computing Steering Committee: Recommends about administrative computing; priorities of administrative system development and modifications of systems; monitors development effort.

Advertising and Promotion Committee: Discussion of advertising and promotion efforts of UT.

Affirmative Action Advisory Committee: Assists in plans and implementation of affirmative action; hears complaints and works on resolutions thereof; sexual harassment shall be investigated by a sub-committee.

Animal Resource Facilities Committee: Supervises maintenance of proper standards of animal facilities and use of animals in research.

Benefits Advisory Committee: Makes recommendations on benefit programs.

Central Board of Student Publications: Jurisdiction over student publications. Selects editor and business manager.

Commencement and Honors Day Committee: Coordinates plans for Commencement and Honors Day ceremony.

Computer Networking and Communications Steering Committee:

Computer Policy and Planning Committee: Looks at computer facilities and programs.

Financial Aid Committee: Recommends budget allocations for institutional financial aid programs.

Honorary Degrees Committee: Reviews nominations for honorary degrees.

Human Subjects Research Committee: Ensuring that research involving human subjects is in accordance with regulations to minimize risk and ensure informed consent.

Intercollege Committee on Advising: Recommend and exchange ideas and information to improve quality of student advising.

International Student Academic Review Committee: Reviews academic issues and works on improving communication between UT units and foreign students.

Library Advisory Committee: Advises Director of Library on policies and problems.

Martin Luther King Scholarship Committee: Responsible for the Martin Luther King Scholarship program.

Outstanding Advisor Award Committee: Nominates each year an advisor to receive the outstanding advisor award.

Patent Committee: Reviews UT patent policies.

Publications Committee: Reviews policies for faculty and UT publications.

Radiation Safety Panel: Reviews policies and procedures as they pertain to radiation safety in all phases of research activities.

Radio Committee: Advises President on station WERC, sets policies and supervises operation.

Residency Committee: In compliance with OBOR requirements, reviews residence status of students and applicants for admission and applies OBOR definitions of residence.

Scholarship Committee: Reviews scholarship programs and recommends on special scholarship funds.

Student Activities Committee: Advising and recommending on all student activities.

Student Grievance Council: Protecting students' rights. Hears grievances.

Traffic Council: Studies campus parking; hears traffic and parking violations appeals.

University Beautification Committee: Recommends projects related to campus beautification.

University College Policy Committee: Provides policy guidance for University College.

University Discipline Appeals Council: Hears appeals and recommends sanctions to the Discipline Officer.

University Distinguished Professorship Committee: Recommends to the President the appointment of University Distinguished Professors.

University Energy Conservation Committee: Conducts studies; reviews energy consumption; recommends on energy conservation.

University Facilities Use Committee: Responsible for scheduling of activities and events for certain non-academic facilities.

University Research Council: Reviewing, formulating and recommending general research policies; overseeing UT research programs; developing new opportunities for enhancing UT research.

University Safety Committee: Safe working conditions; hazardous waste.

University Unity Committee: Foster a positive campus environment; develop programs to integrate principles of diversity; assure adequate group representation in establishing University policies.

Urban Affairs Committee: Concerned with urban-related programs at UT and the Urban Affairs Center.
