
About a week ago, I inquired regarding the ownership of a mace for the University. You informed me that we did not have one but asked whether I thought we should.

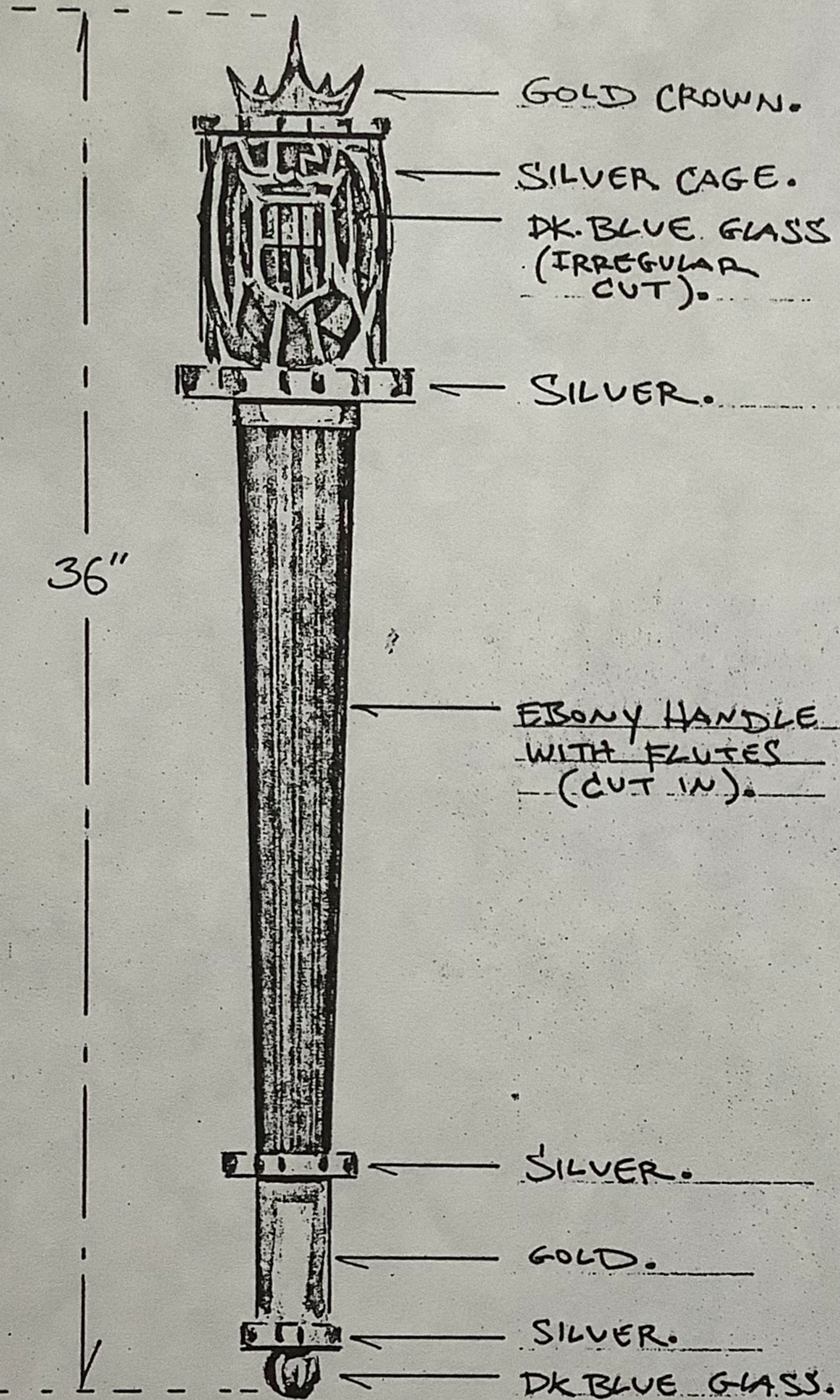
