

## Guidelines for Requesting Learning from Teaching Credit

1. Physicians with UT/PPG faculty appointment may be awarded CME credit based on a 2-to-1 ratio to teaching time. (**2 AMA PRA Category 1 Credits<sup>TM</sup>** for 1 hour spent teaching).
2. Learning must take place in the preparation stage for the purpose of teaching. Neither preparation nor teaching alone are sufficient in and of themselves for the purpose of claiming CME credit.
3. Learning from teaching may be earned by preparation for lectures, clinical clerkships or bedside teaching, etc. Please submit only one form per learning period. Credits should be rounded to the nearest one-quarter credit but must be no less than .50 credits.
4. Faculty CANNOT receive CME credit for Learning from teaching activities with which they have a commercial conflict of interest.
5. Faculty may NOT receive credit more than once for the same period.
6. Teaching must include UT/PPG Medical Students, Residents, or Fellows.
7. Faculty must provide rotation schedule/proof for learning period with submission.
8. CME Faculty Documentation for Learning from Teaching form and Rotation Schedule must be sent by email attachment to:

9. UT CME may request verification from Course Director, Program Director, Clerkship Director, Chair, Division Chief or designee.
