## Minutes: College of Medicine and Life Sciences \*Special\* Faculty Council Meeting Friday, June 2, 2023; 1:00-2:00 pm; HEB103 and WebEx

- 1. Call to Order: COMLS Faculty Council President: Dr. Obi Ekwenna, M.D. called the meeting to order at 1:10pm.
- 2. Discussion on the drafting of the budget resolution: Committee was formed and initial draft sent to faculty for comment and recommendations according to the report from Administration & Finance Dr. Cooper and Dave Walczak concerning the budget on May 22, 2023
  - 6.5M budget reduction for FY24.
  - To recruit clinical faculty, another \$1-2M is needed for FY2024.
  - The Provost's \$6.5 million reduction is independent of potential AAA reductions. In addition to the Provost's \$6.5 million reduction, COMLS is anticipating a AAA reduction of \$2M.
  - Total Budget Reduction = \$6.5M + \$2M + \$1-2M = \$9.5-10.5M.
  - Priorities are to maintain accredited programs, education and the research mission.
  - COMLS 5-year enrollment average is -0.91%
  - How are enrollment declines being addressed in other colleges as our college has been maintaining enrollment numbers over the last 5 yrs?
  - No revenue offsets or one-time budget items will be accepted to meet reductions.
  - Draft budget was submitted last week
  - Current budget at 8M in cuts
  - Staff layoffs are coming vacant positions will not be filled
  - Clinical reductions are affecting the enterprise
  - UT projecting another 5% budget cut next year
  - Faculty to write a resolution on the budget cut target and the negative outcomes of these actions. What is the rationale for the COMLS to incur 40% of the total budget reduction.
  - Committee will be formed and meet on Wednesday to draft resolution.
