REQUIREMENTS



- Personal statement
- 3 Letters of recommendation, and each must be written by US physicians and dated within the past 12 months
- Official medical school transcript (with registrar's signature and seal)
- Dean's letter of MSPE (Medical School Performance Evaluation)
- U.S. Citizenship or J1 visa sponsorships only

SCORE REQUIREMENTS

 USMLE Step 1: Preference is given to candidates who pass on the first attempt and with Step 1 scores of 200 or greater



- USMLE Step 2CK: Preference is given to candidates who pass on the first attempt and with Step 2CK scores of 225 or greater
- <u>USMLE Step 3</u>: Preference is given to FMG candidates who pass on the first attempt.
- COMLEX Level 1: Preference is given to candidates who pass on the first attempt and with Level 1 scores of 425 or greater;
- COMLEX Level 2CE: Preference is given to candidates who pass on the first attempt and with Level 2 CE scores of 425 or greater;
