 Elective Description: In this rotation, the student will spend 2 weeks with the benign gynecology team and 2 weeks on labor and delivery. The student will have the opportunity to participate in the operating room, in-patient rounds, and deliveries. The student will also have the option of participating in the out-patient clinic.
 Length of Clerkship: 4 weeks
