Elective Description/Requirements: The purpose of this rotation is to provide students with an overview of the clinical specialty of General Internal Medicine in a rural setting (Adrian, MI). Students will work in a variety of outpatient, inpatient and continuing care sites. Students will see common adult diseases including Diabetes Mellitus, Hypertension, Coronary Artery Disease, Congestive Heart Failure, Hyper/Hypothyroidism, Electrolyte Disorders, COPD, Acute/Chronic Renal Insufficiency, Anemia, Pneumonia, Diarrhea, Arthritis and Other Musculoskeletal Conditions.
